

Sask Athletics Coach Professional Development Opportunity

Planning (Excel) PD Session

When: Saturday March 6 from 9am-12pm

Where: Zoom (link will be provided to registrants closer to the event.

What: A professional development session for coaches of all event groups on planning and periodization. This session will be split into two sessions. The first, will be a presentation on planning, periodization, and their roles in the athlete development process. The second will be a practical session where participants will be guided through a periodization template excel file that will be provided to the participants as a useable take away from the session.

While this session will provide an informational overview on planning and periodization, it will primarily focus on the needs of athletes who are in focused training groups, with consistent training schedules, and who set defined objective performance gaols (teams, rankings, medals, records, and results).
